
BNB Kennel Contract of Sale

The following is a binding commitment between you as the purchaser and BNB as the breeder of the following Labrador Retriever: **female/male, black/yellow**. MICROCHIP # _____, whelped Date _____. This contract is in effect for the Labrador's entire life. BNB has gone to great lengths to produce top quality Labradors possessing proper temperament, soundness and true versatility. This contract is to preserve and protect the dogs BNB has bred. Having chosen to allow you to purchase a puppy BNB feels comfortable that you will take proper care of said dog. However, in case a problem may arise BNB wish no misunderstandings. BNB will stand behind this contract and trust you will, too.

BNB has agreed to sell you the above Labrador Retriever under the following commitments:

A) The dog will NEVER be allowed to run at large when unattended by you, his owner(s) either at home or elsewhere. Loose animal's only cause problems to themselves, and are a nuisance to your neighbors and friends.

B) The dog will always be given adequate water, food, shelter, veterinary care and attention to ensure he is both happy and healthy. Labradors require human attention, they don't need to be with you all the time but, do not do well if tied outside for extended periods of time without proper exercise and attention. In these cases they often develop barking and chewing habits that are irritating to others and possibly harmful to themselves.

C) The dog will NEVER be kicked, severely handled(including shock collars, pinch collars) or otherwise abused.

D) This puppy is being purchased on a non-breeding agreement. Should you breed said dog without BNB'S written consent you are liable for \$5000.00, (five thousand dollars).

E) If the dog is being purchased for breeding purposes, the non-breeding contract will be released when the following conditions have been met:

1. Dog's eyes are certified normal
2. Dog's hips & elbows are certified normal
3. Dog has obtained his/hers Championship or: 5pts. towards a Champion and either a CD (Companion Dog Cert.) or WC (Working Cert.)
4. Adequate facilities to raise a litter
5. BNB's approval of breeding partner
6. Said dog to be of sound temperament
7. All puppies to be C.K.C. or A.K.C. registered

F) If a time arises that you are unable to keep the puppy for whatever reason (move, allergies, etc.) said dog is to be returned to the breeder immediately. BNB has the right to first refusal, if BNB decides to purchase said **dog/bitch**, BNB will give a full refund less \$150 for administration fee's. It may not be given/sold to anyone else without the breeder's written consent.

G) The dog may never be released to any humane society, pound, research facility, etc. for any amount of money, nor may it be donated.

H) The dog may never be euthanized for any reason without BNB'S written permission. The only exception is an actual medical emergency that requires an immediate decision. This doesn't include broken legs or other injuries that could be repaired. If an emergency does occur please, notify BNB in writing including medical reports. If you are unable to do so, have your Veterinarian send BNB the report.

I) If you require boarding facilities, BNB Kennel will provide this for a nominal charge, for the life of your dog you've purchased, so long as we are available to do this. All we require is that you give adequate notice to arrange this also you must provide the food required for the length of stay.

Failure to abide by any part of this contract will cause you to be liable for \$1500.00, (fifteen hundred dollars), and I will reclaim the dog and find a new more suitable home for said dog. This contract is in effect for the dog's entire life.
